2019 Keynote Speakers



Mary K. Fey,
PhD, RN, CHSE-A, ANEF

Mary Fey has been working in the field of clinical simulation since 2007 and has been responsible for developing clinical simulation programs, integrating simulation into nursing curricula, and designing simulation labs. Currently, her work focuses on faculty development for simulation educators. She is Associate Director and Principal Faculty at the Center for Medical Simulation in Boston, MA.

Dr Fey is a co-author of the Standard of Best Practice for Simulation: Standard VI, The Debriefing Process and Standard IX, Simulation Design. She has completed both qualitative and quantitative studies on debriefing and provides faculty development to interprofessional groups of simulation educators. In her work with the National League for Nursing in Washington, DC, she co-authored the NLN Vision Statements: Teaching with Simulation and Debriefing Across the Curriculum. She is co-editor of the NLN Monograph *Critical Conversations*, a guide for nurse educators.
